EXHIBITORS PLEASE NOTE

1. The committee reserves the right to refuse any entry.
2. Dogs under 18 months of age are not eligible to enter agility classes. The one exception to this is dogs over 15 months who may enter the Nursery class. Dogs six months and over may enter Non-agility novelty classes' e.g Fastest recall.
3. All wins prior to the day specified for the closing of entries shall be taken into account when entering any class.
4. It is the competitor's responsibility to be available for their class.
5. No bitch in season to be present at show.
6. Mating of bitches within the precincts of show grounds is forbidden.
7. It is the exhibitor's responsibility to ensure their dogs are kept under proper control at all times.
8. Flat collars only to be worn while competing in agility tests.
9. Food shall not be given or carried in the ring.
10. No practising with dogs in competition area prior to tests will be allowed. To do so merits disqualification.
11. Handlers will be permitted to walk the agility courses before judging commences.
12. Any article carried by the handler is subject to the judge's discretion, but must be indicated to the judge prior to the commencement of test.
13. The show will be held under the Rules and Regulations of the Irish Agility & Dog Sports Association. All dogs entered for competition must be registered or transferred with the Irish Agility & Dog Sports Association
14. Should the appointed Judge be unable to fulfil their appointment the committee reserve the right to appoint another Judge.
15. Should circumstances so dictate the association or club, in consultation with the Judges may alter arrangements as necessary. Such changes and the circumstances surrounding them must be reported to the Irish Agility and Dog Sports Association.
16. There will be a vet on call.

Entry Fees: €6.00 per dog per class

Unlimited entries: first dog €10.00/dog

Unlimited entries: second and subsequent dog's €5.00/dog

Max. Entry €30.00

Explanation of classes:

Nursery

For young dogs (15 – 18 months) to get some experience of shows on a simple course. The course will not include weaves or see-saw. Handlers can choose what height their dog jumps. Dogs entered in this class may not enter any other classes. Once a dog reaches 18 months of age (on the date of birth) it can no longer compete in the Nursery class.

Elementary For owners, handlers or dogs which have not gained three first places with clear rounds, two of which must be in Agility (not Jumping) classes at any IADSA, IKC or KC licensed Agility shows.

Primary Open to owners, handlers or dogs which are not eligible for Elementary level. Note: Experienced handlers will start their new dogs at this level when the dog is over 18 months.

Secondary Open to dogs which have gained three first places with clear rounds at Primary level, two of which must be gained in Agility (not Jumping) classes.

Graduate Open to dogs which have gained three first places with clear rounds at Secondary level, two of which must be gained in Agility (not Jumping) classes

Masters

Open to dogs which have gained four first places at Graduate level, three of which must be gained in Agility (not Jumping) classes

Open

Open to all grades of dogs in each height category.

Junior Agility For handlers aged 18 years old and under on the day of the show. Dogs will run at their appropriate height but all three heights will be combined to form one class. Note: Handlers must compete in another class with the same dog during the competition in order to be eligible for the Junior class.

Please Note:

This show is being held under IADSA rules where clear round wins will count towards grade progression.

DECLARATON, UNDERTAKING AND AGREEMENT BY OWNER OR AGENT

1. I hereby declare that the dog/dogs entered by me as above are not vicious, and are bona-fide my property, and I enter them subject to the rules and the Regulations of the Show which appear in the schedule and which I have read.
2. I hereby undertake not to bring within the precincts of the show any dog which has (a) distemper or other communicable disease, unless it has been fully recovered for more than 30 days immediately prior to the show or (b) has been in contact with or in any kennel or establishment containing distemper or any other communicable disease during 30 days immediately prior to the show or (c) has been inoculated with distemper virus or displayed any reaction there from during the 30 days immediately prior to the show or (d) has been in contact during the 30 days immediately prior to the show with any dog which was previously inoculated with distemper within 30 days.
3. In consideration of my entry being accepted, I hereby agree (1) to indemnify the IADSA and/or its trustees or officials in respect of any damage or loss from whatsoever source arising, caused by, or to any dogs exhibited by me while in the precincts of the show and (2) that any decision given concerning me by the IADSA or by any committee thereof in connection with any matter whatsoever arising through or at this show shall be communicated by the secretary of the IADSA. To all whom it may concern, and that any such decision together with a report of the proceedings in the matter may also be published together with my name, address and description.
4. I hereby undertake to abide by the rules and regulations of the IADSA and of its show.
5. I undertake to indemnify the promoters against any claims arising out of my participation as a competitor in the show.
