SHOW RULES & REGULATIONS AND INSTRUCTIONS TO EXHIBITORS

1. The Show will be held under the rules of the Irish Kennel Club and a copy of the Rules will be posted in the office of the Secretary on the day of the Show. A 'Dog' in the following rules shall be deemed to mean both sexes.
2. **Date:** The Show will be held on Saturday 31st May 2008 at the National Show Centre, Cloghran, Co. Dublin.
3. **ENTRY FEES:** The entry fee will be: **First Dog** €25.00 **Additional Dogs** €8.00. **Junior Handling Classes** – free if the dog is entered in the breed, otherwise €5.00. **Obedience** - €8.00 per dog per class. **Agility** - €5 per dog per class. Unlimited combined Obedience/Agility €15.00 Pet Plan Junior Stakes €8 (must be entered in breed class)
ENTERING EXHIBITS: Entries will be received up to and including Friday 25th April 2008(postmark). Entries must be made on the form issued for this purpose. Entry forms must be completed in ink. Details of entries and fees to be sent to **The Show Secretary, The Irish Kennel Club, Fottrell House, Harold's Cross Bridge, Dublin 6W.**
ENTRY FORMS: The Catalogue will be compiled from the Entry Forms submitted by Exhibitors, and the Irish Kennel Club cannot accept any responsibility for mistakes therein.
EXHIBITORS SHALL BE ENTITLED TO FREE PASSES TO THE SHOW: i.e. 1 free pass for 1 or 2 dogs; 2 free passes for 3 or 4 dogs and so on.
4. **REJECTING ENTRIES:** etc.: The Committee reserves the right to reject any entry, advertisement or other insertion in the Catalogue or the allocation of Stand Space at the Show.
INELIGIBLE ENTRIES: A transfer of an incorrect entry as to sex or breed may be allowed by the Secretary prior to the commencement of judging and a dog entered in a class for which it is not eligible may be transferred to the next appropriate age class in that breed otherwise to the Open Class but in no other respects.
5. **REGISTRATIONS:** All Dogs entered for competition or otherwise, must be registered or transferred at the Irish Kennel Club or another FCI member Kennel Club. Entries for Greyhounds already registered with the Irish Coursing Club will be accepted without further registration.
6. **PRIZE CARDS** will be given to 1st, 2nd, 3rd and Reserve in each Class. **Rosettes** will be given to Green Star winners, Best of Breed, Group winners & Reserve Group winners, to 4th place. Best in Show, Reserve Best in Show, to 4th place. Best Puppy in Breed, Best Puppy in Group, Best Puppy in Show & Reserve Best Puppy in Show to 4th place.
7. **PRIZES WITHHELD:** A Judge shall be empowered to withhold any prize, prizes or Green Stars if in his (or her) opinion, the exhibits are not of sufficient merit.
8. **WHERE SPECIAL PRIZES** are offered for competition by or through a Specialist Club, they are responsible for the collection and distribution same.
9. **EXHIBITS NOT SENT:** Persons entering an exhibit or exhibits and failing to send them for exhibition or should their exhibit or exhibits be rejected by one of the Veterinary Surgeons, will forfeit the entrance fees paid in respect of such exhibit or exhibits.
The Irish Kennel Club cannot accept any responsibility for the absence of any dog when the judging of a Breed or Class or Group is about to commence.
10. **VETERINARY EXAMINATION:** Any Veterinary Surgeon acting with the Authority of the Show Committee may have any dog removed from the Show on any of the following grounds: (i) suspected cause of infection or contagious disease (ii) totally blind or deaf (iii) castrated (iv) vicious or savage disposition. If requested by the Show Secretary, the Veterinary Surgeon shall

give such order in writing, together with the reason for it.

11. **OPENING OF THE SHOW:** The Show will be open from 6.30am. The price of admission for persons other than exhibitors will be:- Car & Driver €5, Car & Driver with passengers €10, payable at gate. Admissions for person without a car and payable at the Main Hall entrance, is Adults €5, Children & OAP €3, Family Ticket €10. Associate Members of the Irish Kennel Club admitted free upon production of current Membership Card.
12. **CAR PARK:** €5.00 per car. €4 if prepaid.
13. **STANDS:** Sales of any article will only be permitted to take place from a duly licensed stand. (Anywhere in the Grounds)
14. **CATALOGUES:** will be on sale within the Showgrounds. Price €5.00 each. €4.00 if prepaid.
15. **CLOSING OF THE SHOW:**
All exhibits must be removed by the person in charge, or by their owners not later than half an hour after completion of the Judging of Best in Show.
16. **JUDGES:** If circumstances arise to prevent any judge selected from keeping his or her engagement, the Committee reserves the right to employ another judge. The right is reserved to the Show Committee or to the Chairman of the Irish Kennel Club to change a judge in a breed or breeds, or part of a breed if it is considered such a change is in the best interests of the Show.
17. **JUDGING:**
 - (a) Will commence at 8.30a.m.
 - (b) No person will be allowed in Judging Ring, except the Judge, Show Official or any exhibitor taking in a dog for adjudication.
 - (c) Exhibitors will not be allowed to wear a badge or other decoration in the Breed Judging Ring save the exhibition number of each dog which must be clearly displayed by the exhibitor.
 - (d) The following officials of the Show will not be permitted to exhibit thereat. viz: a Judge, a Veterinary Surgeon, a Steward (except when acting as such and in the execution of his duties) the Show Committee, the Secretary or any member of the Irish Kennel Club Staff.
18. **JUDGE'S DECISION:** The decision of a Judge at the termination of his or her judging a Class shall be final, except in the case of an objection properly made and upheld under the Rules of the Irish Kennel Club or where a Judge states that a clerical or other mistake was made in the award as officially returned, or on the grounds of fraud.
19. **PROTEST:** All protests must be made in the manner specified in Irish Kennel Club Rules.
20. **RESPONSIBILITY:**
 - (a) The Irish Kennel Club will not be responsible for any loss or damage sustained by an exhibitor through accident or otherwise.
 - (b) The Irish Kennel Club will not be responsible for any accident, that may occur to any exhibitor or other person attending the Show.
 - (c) Visitors are requested not to handle the dogs sent for exhibition.
 - (d) Dog will not be permitted in the Bar or Refreshment Rooms.
21. **ALL ANNOUNCEMENTS** appearing in any daily newspaper or other publication in reference to any alterations made by the Show Committee in the Schedule or in these regulations, shall be deemed sufficient notice thereof.
22. **IN CONNECTION WITH THE SHOW:**
 - (a) The General Purposes Committee of the Irish Kennel Club shall be the Show Committee within the meaning of the Rules, and all disputes arising shall be dealt with by this Committee in accordance with the powers delegated to it by the Council.

- (b) Should any dispute arise for which a specific rule is not provided such matter in dispute shall be referred to the General Purposes Committee for decision. Parties to any such dispute shall have the right to appeal to the Council of the Irish Kennel Club. The Chairman of the Irish Kennel Club Show Committee shall be given Executive Powers to decide any point arising at the Show.
 - (c) During the exhibition of Dogs at this show the officiating Judge will not allow under any circumstances any form of distraction by ring-siders and will disqualify any exhibit which is being assisted in its performance by any person other than the handler.
23. **FOULING:** A minimum fine of €50.00 shall be imposed on any exhibitor who fails to clean up fouling by their dogs in the precincts of the show.
24. **ALL DOGS** competing must be on a lead, unless when under a judge.

RULES FOR GROUP JUDGING & BEST IN SHOW

1. The Irish Kennel Club will not accept any responsibility nor be under any obligation to see that dogs eligible to compete are exhibited in their particular Groups, or for Best in Show, other than announcing in the ring that judging is about to take place. The Irish Kennel Club will not accept any responsibility in the case of an exhibit that is excluded from competing in a Group, owing to the judging of its breed not having been completed, or for any other reason.
2. Competition in Group Classes will be confined to undefeated winners.
3. No dog shall be entitled to compete in a Group where any prize or award has been withheld from it at the show.
4. No fee is payable for entry in any of the Groups nor for Best in Show.
5. Groups will be divided into 10 sections as defined in the Irish Kennel Club Rules & Regulations.
6. Upon entering the Group Ring Competitors must produce their Best of Breed and Green Star Card.
7. In each Group and Best in Show the judges shall make the following awards: viz, 1st, 2nd, 3rd & 4th place, absentees MUST be marked.
8. Competition for Best in Show is confined to the winners of the 10 groups. Competition for the award of Reserve Best in Show will be confined to the winners of Groups and the 2nd winner in that Group from which came the winner of Best in Show.
9. If the Group Judging has not commenced before 4:30 p.m. a Best of Breed winner may leave the show but must notify the Show Secretary in writing that the exhibit will not be present for the Group judging. Otherwise all exhibits qualified for the Group must be exhibited therein. An exhibit failing to report for the Group will incur a fine of €50 unless a valid reason is lodged with the Show Secretary before judging commences.

BEST PUPPY

In addition to the standard Groups, Puppy Groups will be scheduled and the winner of each Puppy Group may proceed to challenge for Best Puppy in Show. The Best Puppy in each breed will be eligible to compete.

BEST VETERAN

The Best Veteran in each breed (unless it wins best of its own breed) will be eligible to compete for Best Veteran. If a Veteran wins Best of its own breed it will not be eligible to compete in the Veteran Group but will proceed like all Best of Breed winners to compete in the standard Group.

INTERNATIONAL BEAUTY CHAMPION

The Irish Kennel Club can only apply to the F.C.I. for this title in respect of dogs owned by Irish residents. All others must apply directly to their own national Kennel Club.

SECTION 1 – RULE 7 – REGISTRATION

Every dog exhibiting or competing at any Show, Field Trial or Obedience Test, must be registered with the Irish Kennel Club or another FCI member Kennel Club in the name of the exhibitor or competitor, save in the case of Greyhounds duly registered with the Irish Coursing Club.

Failure to comply with the above will result in (a) the dog being disqualified from the event and (b) the exhibitor being fined €127 – the implementation of which shall be a normal office routine. All appeals to the Irish Kennel Club should carry a fee of €6, refundable if the appeal is upheld.

PHOTOGRAPHY

It is an Irish Kennel Club regulation that permission must be sought from the Show promoting body for the use of cameras or other recording equipment. Permission must also be obtained from the judge in the ring of the day. (Subject to Regulation 17 paragraph (b))

Irish Kennel Club C.A.C.I.B. and Green Star Show

The F.C.I. requires that Judges must compare each individual exhibit to their standard and grade them accordingly. Dog of exceptional quality are considered for C.A.C.I.B (International Certificate) and Green Star (National Certificate)

1. **Grading**

After each examination all dogs must be graded one of the following by the judge i.e. "E" (Excellent), "VG" (Very Good) "G" (Good), etc. and Puppy Grading: Very Promising, Promising and Good. **Each exhibitor will be given a Grading Card by the Steward**

2. **Green Star (National Title)**

Only unbeaten dogs **Graded Excellent** are eligible to challenge for the Green Star.
Reserve Green Star: Confined to dogs beaten only by the Green Star winner.

3. **C.A.C.I.B. and Reserve**: Confined to dogs over 15 months old with an "E" (Excellent) grading.

4. **Best of Breed** - Confined to Green Star winners.

Note: (a) Where a dog under 15 months wins a Green Star and is not eligible for the C.A.C.I.B. the Judge Must award it to another qualified dog.
(b) All grades and awards must be completed by the Judge in the Judges book.

5. **Best Puppy In Breed**

Confined to winners of the puppy classes who have been awarded the **Grade of Very Promising**

Note Carefully:

1. Only dogs entered at this Show are allowed on the Show Grounds.
2. Dogs between the ages of three and six months are not eligible to compete at this show.
3. Dogs entered in restricted classes must also be entered in one of the Standard Classes for the breed.
4. All dogs entered for this Show must be registered or transferred at the Irish Kennel Club or other FCI member Kennel Club, in the name of the Exhibitor.

10 to 12 years, 13 to 14 years, 15 to 17 years

OBEDIENCE

Beginners, Novice, Graduate, Limit, Open

AGILITY

Premier, Open, Novice, Preliminary, Introductory, Small Dogs, Jumping Class, Team Jumping, Team Agility, Small Dog Jumping, Small Dog Agility, Open Jumping.

PETPLAN JUNIOR STAKES

Dogs (6 to 18 months) Bitches (6 to 18 months)

CLASS DEFINITIONS

(The word 'Dog' includes both sexes)

A Puppy Class is confined to dogs over six and under nine months of age on the day of the Show.

(Puppies may not compete for the Green Star or CACIB)

A Junior Class is for dogs between nine and eighteen calendar months of age on the first day of the Show computed from and inclusive of the date of its birth. **(Dogs entered in this class are not eligible to compete for the CACIB but may compete for the Green Star)**

An Intermediate Class is for dogs between 15 and 24 calendar months of age on the day of the Show.

Open Class is for dogs over 15 months of age on the day of the Show.

Champions Class is for dogs who have gained the title of Champion under Irish Kennel Club rules or under another recognised Kennel Authority confirmed by the date of closing of entries. **

Veteran Class is for dogs over eight years of age on the day of the Show **(Dogs entered in this class are not eligible to compete for the CACIB)** Please note – a Veteran Dog who is also a Champion may enter in either Veteran or Champion Class but not both.**.**

Working Class To enter a dog in working class, the entry form must be accompanied by a copy of the FCI compulsory certificate containing the confirmation -by the member country in which the holder and/or owner has his permanent place of residence- that the dog has passed the test as well as details about this test. The only breeds eligible for the working class are those appearing as working breeds in the FCI Breed Nomenclature, taking into account the exceptions granted to some countries for some breeds.

The decisive date in respect of age is the day the dog is shown.

Breeds not separately listed at International Championship Shows

All Breeds qualified by the FCI to compete for the International Beauty Title must be afforded the opportunity to do so at All Breed International Shows. In order to facilitate this, the Any Variety Class is replaced by a class entitled **Breeds Not Listed** which must be scheduled in each of the ten groups.

Entries received in this class must be divided into breed sections. A Judge may award a CACIB, Green Star, and Best of Breed to any dog unbeaten and eligible, if in his/her opinion they are of sufficient quality. When entries are received Judges for these classes will be allocated by the show promoting body and exhibitors informed when they are sent their ring numbers. The names of the judges will be listed in the catalogue.

OBEDIENCE CLASS DEFINITIONS

Beginners Obedience Class: Confined to dogs and handlers which have not won 3 or more first prizes in any Obedience Test.

Novice Obedience Class: Confined to dogs which have not been awarded (a) a Green Star in any obedience Test or (b) four first prizes or more in any Obedience Test other than Beginners.

Graduate Obedience: Confined to dogs which have not been awarded (a) a Green Star in any Obedience Test or (b) four first prizes or more in any Obedience Test with the exception of Beginners and/or Novice.

Limit Obedience: Confined to dogs which have not been awarded (a) a Green Star in any Obedience Test or (b) four first prizes in any Obedience Test with the exception of Beginners and/or Novice and/or Graduate Classes.

Open Obedience: Open to any dog of any breed or variety.

AGILITY CLASS DEFINITIONS

Premier Agility: Open to dogs who have won out of Novice and Preliminary Classes.

Open Agility: Open to all dogs. Max. height of hurdles 30", Max. long jump 60"

Novice Agility: Confined to dogs who have not won five first prizes in Novice agility or two first prizes in Open Agility. Max. height of hurdles 30", Max. long jump 42"

Preliminary Agility: Confined to dogs (a) who have not won five first prizes in Preliminary Agility: (b) dogs who have not won three first prizes in Novice Agility or two first prizes in Open Agility. Max. height of hurdles 24" Max. long jump 30"

Introductory Agility: Confined to dogs that have not been placed 1st-4th in any Irish Kennel Club Scheduled Agility Class.

Small Dog Agility: Confined to dogs under 15" at shoulder. Max Height of hurdles 15"

Open Jumping: Open to all dogs Max height 30" long jump 30"

Team Jumping: Team is confined to four dogs. Jumps as per Open Jumping. Format to be decided by the judge on the day.

Team Agility. Team is confined to four dogs. Jumps as per Open Jumping. Format to be decided by the judge on the day.

JUNIOR HANDLING CLASS DEFINITIONS

Group 1: 10 - 12 Years of age (i.e. to the 13th Birthday)

Group 2: 13 - 14 Years of age (i.e. to the 15th Birthday)

Group 3: 15 - 17 Years of age (i.e. to the 18th Birthday)

(A declaration is required from the parent or guardian of each handler in relation to the child's age.)

PETPLAN JUNIOR STAKES

1. Separate Dog and Bitch "qualifying" classes will be held, and the Petplan Junior Stakes "Final" will be held during the afternoon.

One dog and one bitch to qualify from each class, which will give a total of two in the "Final"

One overall winning dog or bitch will then be chosen as the "Petplan Junior Winner"

2. Placing in the two qualifying classes as follows:-
1st, 2nd, 3rd, Reserve, VHC. With prize money as follows:- 1st €30, 2nd €25. 3rd €20. Reserve €15. and VHC €10. Rosettes will be given out for all placing.
3. Placing in the "Final" 1st and 2nd with prize money as follows. 1st €200 and a trophy, 2nd €75. Rosettes to be given to both winner and runner-up.
