## EXHIBITORS PLEASE NOTE

1. The committee reserves the right to refuse any entry.
2. Dogs under 18 months of age are not eligible to enter agility tests. Dogs six months and over may enter class 12.
3. All wins prior to the day specified for the closing of entries shall be taken into account when entering any class.
4. It is the competitor's responsibility to be available for their class.
5. No bitch in season to be present at show.
6. Mating of bitches within the precincts of show grounds is forbidden.
7. Dogs must be kept under proper control at all times.
8. Collars are not to be worn while competing in agility tests.
9. Food shall not be given or carried in the ring.
10. No practising with dogs in competition area prior to tests will be allowed. To do so merits disqualification.
11. Handlers will be permitted to walk the agility courses before judging commences.
12. Any article carried by the handler is subject to the judge's discretion, but must be indicated to the judge prior to the commencement of test.
13. The show will be held under the Licence, Rules and Regulations of the Irish Kennel Club Limited. All dogs entered for competition must be registered or transferred at the Irish Kennel Club Limited.
14. No email entries will be accepted.
15. The dogs registration number or microchip number must be given on the form.
16. Incorrectly filled out entry forms will be returned.
17. All competitors must show respect for the judge. Training dogs will only be allowed if prior permission is given by the judge.
18. Children must be supervised and kept under control at all times.

### Class Definitions

**Class 1. Premier Agility** is confined to dogs who have won out of Preliminary and Novice Agility. Max height of hurdles 2'1.6".

**Class 2. Premier Small Dog Agility** as per class 1. Dogs entered in this class may not enter Introductory agility.

**Class 3: Open Agility** is open to all dogs. Max height of hurdles 2'1.6", max long jump 5'.

**Class 4: Novice Agility** is confined to dogs which have not won 5 first prizes in Novice or 2 first prizes in Open Agility. Max height of hurdles 2'1.6", max long jump 3'6"

**Class 5: Small Dog Agility** is confined to dogs under 15" (Note: Dogs entered in classes 1, 3 or 4 may not enter this class) Max height of hurdles 15", max long jump 30"

**Class 6: Preliminary Agility** is confined to (a) dogs which have not won 5 first prizes in Preliminary or (b) dogs which have not won 3 first prizes in Novice or (c) dogs which have not won 2 first prizes in Open Agility. Max height of hurdles 24" max long jump 30"

**Class 7 : Introductory Agility** is for owners, handlers or dogs which have not gained more than four first places in any Agility and/or jumping class at an IKC licensed Agility test excluding Small Dogs class. Max. jump height 18" and Max. long jump 30". Dogs entered in class. Dog entered in Class 1, 2 or 3 may not enter this class.

**Class 8: Small dog jumping** Dogs under 15" at shoulder (Dogs entered in classes 9 may not enter this class)

**Class 9: Open jumping** Open to all dogs. Max height of hurdles 2'1.6".

### **Good Citizen Dog Scheme**

Assessments for the good citizen dog awards will be carried out at our club at the show.

If you are interested in having your dog(s) assessed please let us know by completing the separate entry form. It is not necessary to compete in agility or obedience to take part.

Payments for the assessment will be taken on the day. €5 IKC fee.

I hereby undertake not to bring within the precincts of the show any dog which has distemper or other communicable disease, unless it has been fully recovered for more than 30 days immediately prior to the show or (b) has been in contact with or in any kennel or establishment containing distemper or any other communicable disease during 30 days immediately prior to the show or (c) has been inoculated with distemper virus or displayed any reaction therefrom during the 30 days immediately prior to the show or (d) has been in contact during the 30 days immediately prior to the show with any dog which was previously inoculated with distemper within 30 days.
4. In consideration of my entry being accepted, I hereby agree (1) to indemnify the IKC Ltd and/or its trustees or officials in respect of any damage or loss from whatsoever source arising, caused by, or to any dogs exhibited by me within the precincts of the show and (2) that any decision given concerning me by the IKC Ltd or by any committee thereof in connection with any matter whichsoever arising through or at this show shall be communicated by the secretary of the IKC Ltd. To all whom it may concern and that any such decision together with a report of the proceedings in the matter may also be published together with my name, address and description.
5. I hereby undertake to abide by the rules and regulations of the IKC Ltd, and of its show.
6. I undertake to indemnify the promoters against any claims arising out of my participation as a competitor in the show.
